

1st Thursday 2022-2023 Guide

What is 1st Thursday?

Is Thursday was started by Downtown Santa Barbara (DSB) in February 2007 and has since grown significantly in popularity and visibility in the community and beyond. Is Thursday offers locals and visitors the opportunity to tour downtown galleries and art venues free of charge, in a relaxed and social environment on the first Thursday evening of each month. In addition to the exhibits, performances and programs at the various venues, DSB enhances the evening's experience with live, interactive, educational and seasonal presentations outdoors, along State Street, giving Is Thursday-goers added entertainment while strolling between the various venues.



Participation Benefits

As a participant* in I^{st} Thursday your organization receives many benefits provided and coordinated by DSB. These benefits currently include:

Marketing and Advertising (Monthly)

- Your name, address, current event description and featured event photo included in the professionally designed and printed Passport brochures
 - $^{\circ}$ Your venue noted by number on the map inside the Passport and in printed advertising for l^{st} Thursday-goers to easily find your venue
 - Passports on display and distributed at more than 50 locations each month
- Your name, address, website, current event description and featured event photo included on the *1st Thursday* website with downloadable Passport at http://www.downtownsb.org/events/1st-thursday (averaging 3,500 page views per month)
- Your name and address included in one or more printed *I*st *Thursday* advertisements per month, publications may include the *Santa Barbara Independent* (40,000 distribution), *Voice Magazine* (20,000 readers), and the Montecito Journal (25,000 distribution).
- Event information included in a monthly *1st Thursday*-specific email newsletter sent to more than 4,000 Downtown Santa Barbara contacts with an average open rate over 50%
- Your business tagged and featured in a 1st Thursday-specific story on the DSB Instagram account (33k+ followers as of July 2022)
- Your business tagged and featured in a 1st Thursday-specific Facebook post (11.5k+ followers as of July 2022)
- 1st Thursday included in the Event Calendar on the DSB website (averaging 3,500 hits per month)
- 1st Thursday included in numerous local Event Calendars (including but not limited to: Visit Santa Barbara, NightOut, EventBrite, SB Independent, Noozhawk, and SB to Do)

Administrative

- Opportunity to obtain a Special One Day Event Permit* endorsed by DSB, to serve alcohol during *1st Thursday* (\$50 license fee to serve beer and wine only -OR- \$75 license fee to serve beer, wine, and full liquor)
- Event coordination of deadlines, descriptions and forms by DSB staff
- Production and distribution of all marketing and promotional material by DSB staff
- Event and marketing assistance available by DSB staff
- 1st Thursday Destination signage provided by DSB staff
- Participants' right to use current 1st Thursday logo and name in marketing and advertising



Additional

- DSB provides 1-3 additional monthly activities and performances to enhance the evening's experience with live music, interactive activities and performances, located outside along State Street
- DSB continues to support the *1st Thursday* program with funds and staff to enhance the Cultural Arts District and encourage both locals and visitors to come downtown and experience everything Downtown Santa Barbara has to offer

Annual Commitment Benefits

- Includes discounted participation fees
- Option for payment plans by invoice
- Option for monthly auto-pay payment plan

Passport Cover Opportunities

- As a *1st Thursday* participant, you have the opportunity to purchase the passport cover. Purchasing the cover is an additional \$300.00 per month and will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- Includes image of choice, credits and venue name to appear on the cover (1,200-1,800 distributed monthly)

*Note:

1st Thursday participation is limited to DSB members in good standing. All dues, fees and assessments must be paid in full before a venue may participate.

*Downtown Santa Barbara meets all requirements and is qualified by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC). Venues interested in applying for a Special One Day Event Permit must do so through DSB, must follow the rules outlined by DSB and be approved by the Santa Barbara Police Department.

NOTE: A permit is required to serve alcohol during 1st Thursday.

Quick Start Guide

Steps to participate in 1st Thursday:

- 1) Read this guide
- 2) Determine your level of participation (Annual, 6-month, 3-month, or monthly)
- 3) Complete the Participation Agreement
- 4) Complete the Hold Harmless Waiver
- 5) Complete the new 2022 ABC Form (only if you'd like to serve beer, wine, and/or alcohol during your *I*st *Thursday* event. Note: if your business already has a liquor license this step is not necessary)
- 6) Submit forms and payment to DSB staff
- 7) Submit your event information (through the DSB web portal):
 - a. Image (600 x 600 pixels)
 - b. 50-word event description (What will take place during your event? Who is the featured artist, band, live performance, etc?)

any and all liability of every nature, known or unknown, from all claims and causes of action that may result by reason of injury to the undersigned which has been sustained, and from any and all damages to property belonging to the undersigned that may result because of his or her participation in *Ist Thursday*.

The undersigned also agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Downtown Santa Barbara from any and all claims and demands for injury and/or damage to property or persons (including any costs and/or fees incurred to defend against any such claims or demands) including, but not limited to, event participants at their venue.
